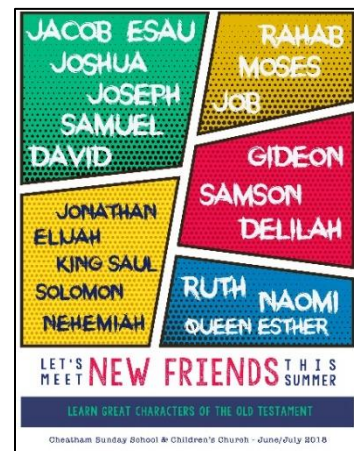

PRAYER FOCUS: The Blessing of God

One of the most beautiful blessings in all the world is found in this passage: "The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine on you and be gracious unto you, the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace." Numbers 6:22-26. God's presence among His people is a blessing. We can see these blessings of God and count them one by one, day by day, when we look at Psalm 103. The psalmist tells us, "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless His holy name." (Psalm 103:1) That is the essence of where the Christian life begins. Then again, "Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits." (verse 2) How often the Bible makes it clear that a very important part of the Christian life is remembering...remember and forget not. Pray that God will give us a good memory of His blessings. Read all of Psalm 103 and review the blessings in this one Psalm. Pray for summer safety, VBS plans, willing workers. Ask for Godly wisdom, anointing of the Holy Spirit, and God's favor. The blessings of God overflow in the life of His obedient children.

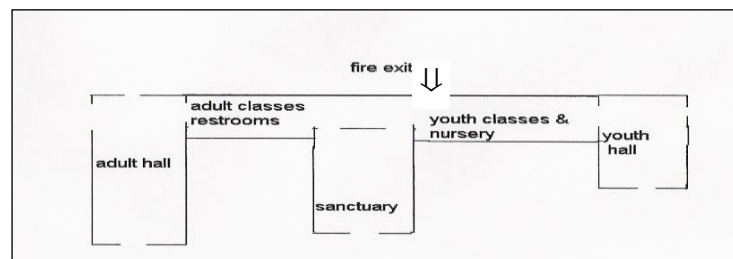
