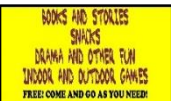

June 6, 1944

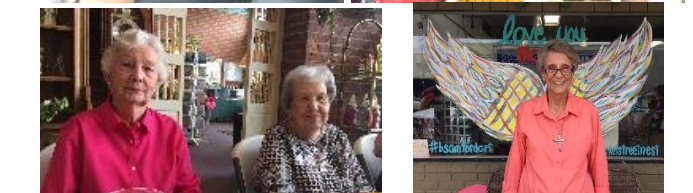

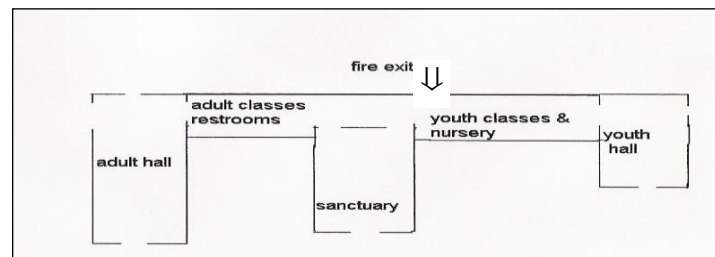
