Prayer Focus: James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him. When was the last time we drew near to the Lord and ask Him to give us wisdom for the situations we were facing at the moment? This verse is the key that unlocks the door. God wants us to come to Him first and firmly ask Him for wisdom. Approach Him with respect, honor and out of love for Him. There is a condition we must meet to receive wisdom from God. We see this in the phrase "of God". Of God means to come alongside of Him. This depicts an intimate position next to Him. God wants a relationship with us. He wants us to come to Him, then He opens His hand and reveals everything we need to know and understand. God will not rebuke you or reprove you for asking for wisdom. We are His children and wants us to have the wisdom we need for life. Come alongside of Him, where He can love us and fellowship with us.

Ask for God's wisdom, anointing of Holy Spirit and God's favor.

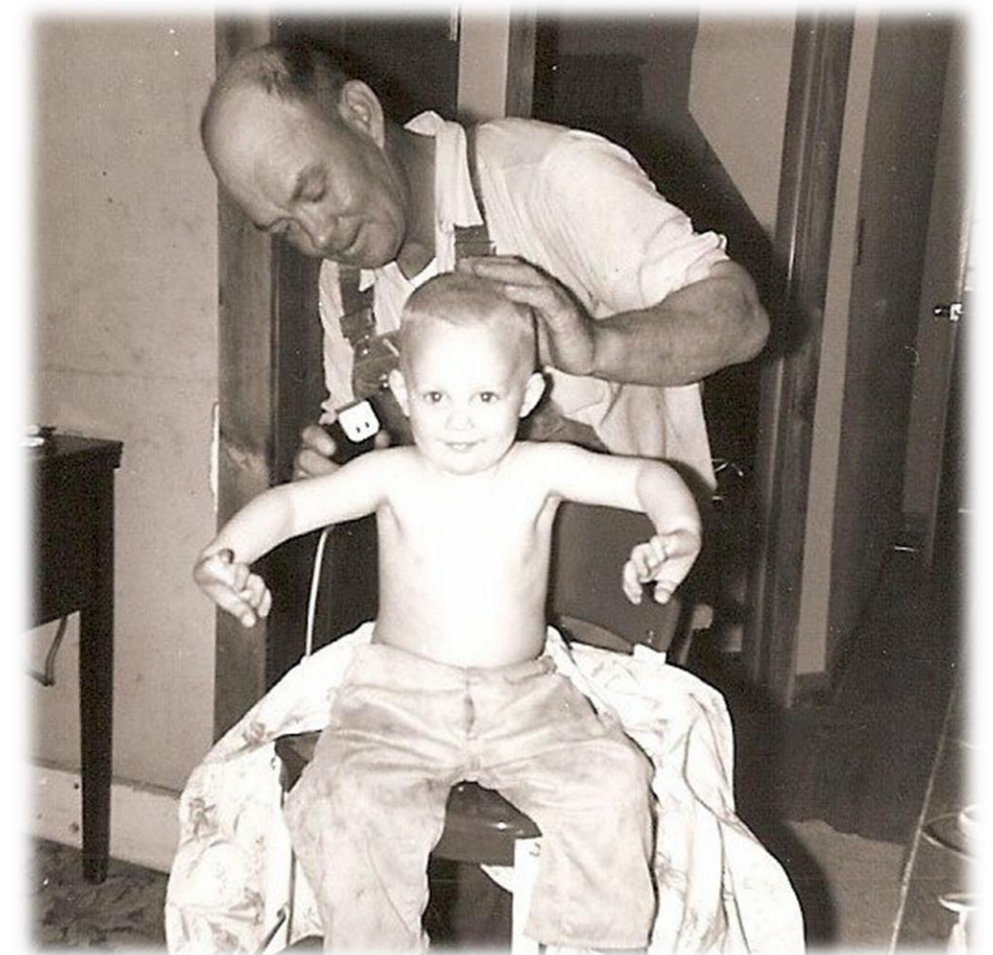
