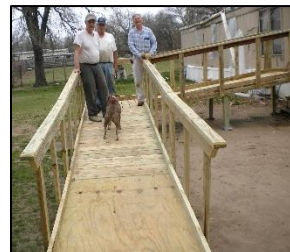

Jesus valued us above claiming what was rightfully His by humbling Himself and dying for our sins. May the Joy of the Lord fill our hearts. Let encouragement and love radiate from each of us.

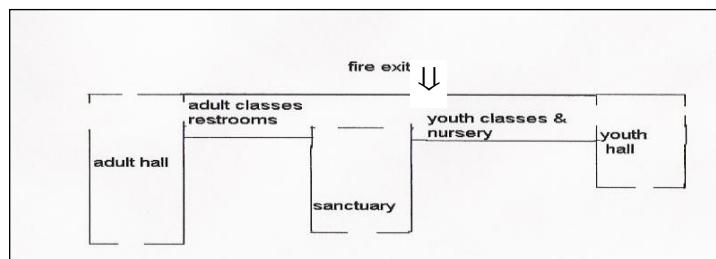
