Prayer Focus: Forgiveness-Psalm 32:1 Blessed (Happy, fortunate, to be envied) is he who has forgiveness of his transgression (Amplified) King David expresses in this Psalm the joy we can feel as we are forgiven of our sins. Forgiveness is an act of the will and not emotion. Forgiveness is being obedient to God's word. Let me forgive as you have forgiven me. The greatest need people have is forgiveness and salvation from their sins. That's why Jesus died on the cross. What happens when someone repents of wrong and truly repents? Peoples lives change. Hearts and attitude change as reconciliation and forgiveness happen. There is freedom Jesus said in Luke 17:3..." If he repents, forgive Him." Forgive in Greek means to set free, to let go, to liberate completely. Just as God has removed your sins as far as the east is from the west (Psalm 103:12) we must learn to forgive also! Forgiveness means we let it go and we don't drag up the offence again and again. Precious Lord give us a spirit of gentleness humility, and compassion so that we may live and forgive out of the abundance of grace you have shown us. In Jesus name! Amen
Pray and ask for forgiveness. Ask for Godly wisdom and discernment in whom I have wronged. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide in what I should say when asking for forgiveness. Take every opportunity to make things right. Joy comes in reconciliation.

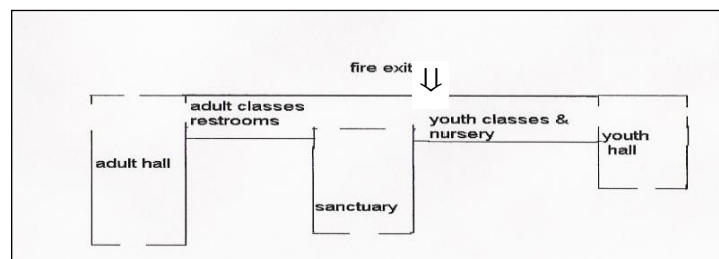

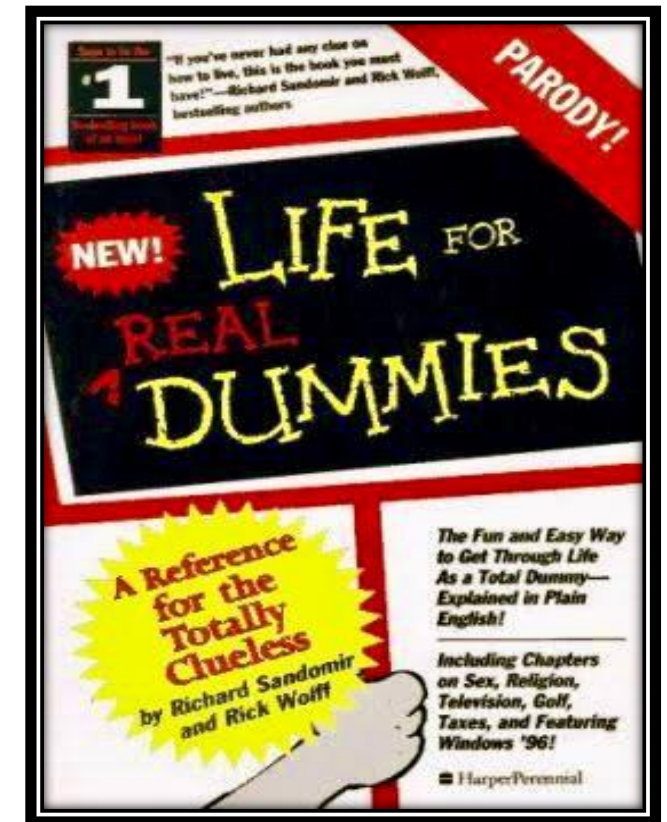

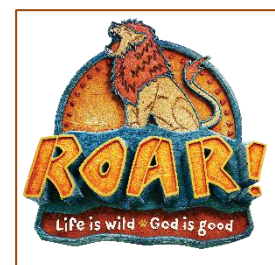
