Children's Church Lesson: Sept. 8 – Paul series: The conversion of Paul
Blessings: Children's Church Lesson - Our focus today was on the Apostles, in particularly Stephen, and the trials they faced as they spoke the truth about Jesus.

We observed what happens to lit candles (apostles) when they are placed in water (jail) and are covered without oxygen (made to suffer). The flame will go out, but the water will fill the vase and the candles will float just as the apostles rose to martyrdom.

We wrote mean things on paper stones and nice things on others to remind us that stones aren't always from the Earth, they can come from our mouths. Then we made soft stones out of balloons and flour and had some brave martyrs volunteer to be stoned as Mrs. Ine shared a real-life experience of a stoning taking place in another country.

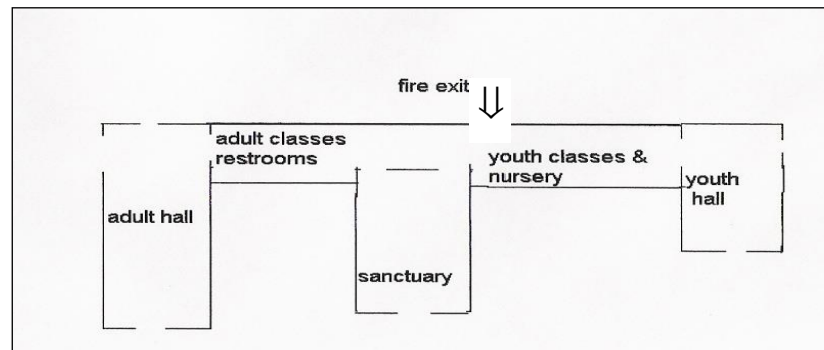
