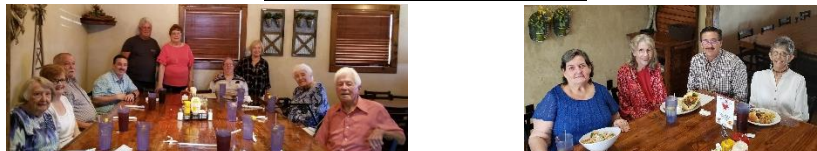

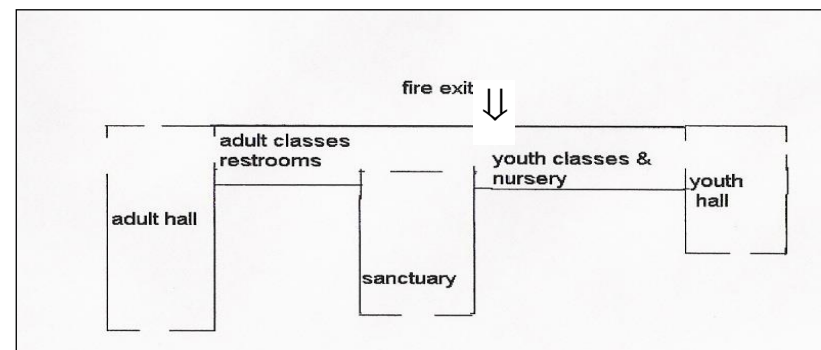

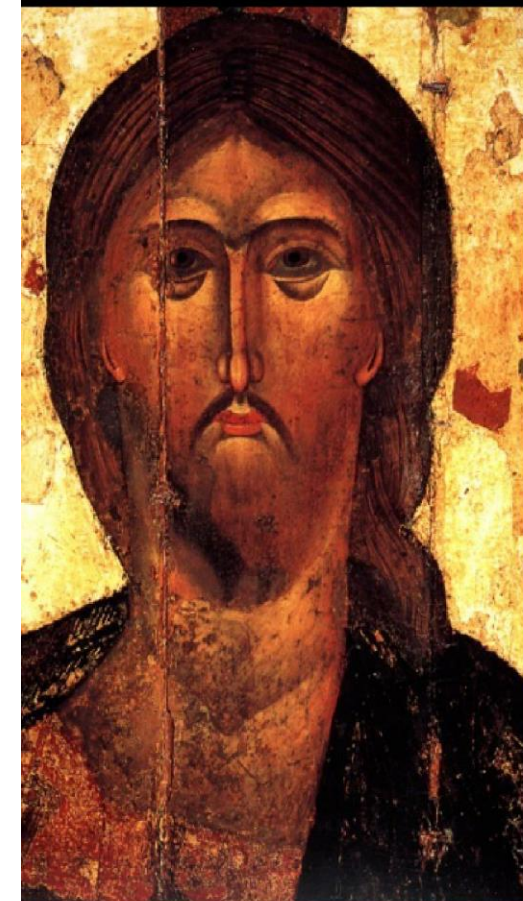
About Us...
